PRIVACY POLICY

Website, Site Membership, Forms & Youth Sports Information

This Privacy Policy explains how Warriors FC may collect, use, disclose, retain, and protect information through its website, site-member accounts, forms, tryouts, programs, communications, and related services. By using the website or submitting information, you acknowledge this Policy to the extent permitted by applicable law.

IMPORTANT: This Policy describes information practices. It does not replace a specific consent, photo/video release, medical authorization, liability waiver, registration agreement, or other document that may be required for participation.

This Policy is intended as an operational privacy notice and should be reviewed by qualified California privacy counsel before final adoption, particularly because Warriors FC serves minors and may collect health, emergency, and other sensitive information.

1. Information We May Collect

We may collect information that you voluntarily provide and information generated through use of the website or related services. The information collected depends on the service and your relationship with Warriors FC.

Contact and identity information: name, email address, telephone number, mailing address, date of birth, and similar information.

Parent/guardian and participant information: parent or legal guardian name and contact information, participant information, team/division information, tryout information, roster information, and relationship to the participant.

Emergency and health-related information: emergency contacts, allergies, relevant medical information, injury or incident information, and other safety information when reasonably necessary for participation, emergency response, insurance, or club administration.

Coach information: contact information, coaching role, team assignment, onboarding information, acknowledgments, certifications or training information, and information submitted through coach forms.

Financial and transaction information: payment status, invoices, fees, purchases, refunds, fundraising information, reimbursement information, and transaction records. Payment-card information may be processed directly by a third-party payment provider rather than stored by Warriors FC.

Communications and submissions: messages, form submissions, reports, requests, photographs, documents, and other information you choose to provide.

Technical information: IP address, device/browser information, pages visited, approximate usage information, and similar technical data that may be collected automatically by the website or its service providers.

2. Information About Minors

Warriors FC is a youth sports organization and may collect information about minor participants from parents, legal guardians, authorized coaches, administrators, or other authorized persons.

Parents and legal guardians should provide information about a minor only when they have appropriate authority to do so. We ask that users avoid submitting unnecessary sensitive information.

Warriors FC uses minor participant information for legitimate club purposes such as registration, eligibility, safety, emergency response, team administration, communication, insurance, scheduling, and program operations.

Where applicable law requires parental consent or another specific authorization for collection or use of a minor's information, Warriors FC will follow the applicable requirement.

3. How We Use Information

Warriors FC may use information to operate and administer its programs and website, including:

- processing registrations, tryouts, onboarding, and participation requirements;
- communicating with parents, guardians, players, coaches, volunteers, and administrators;
- maintaining rosters and program records;
- confirming eligibility, required documentation, insurance status, and participation requirements;
- responding to incidents, injuries, emergencies, safety concerns, and reports;
- administering facilities, equipment, tournaments, events, and team activities;
- processing or recording payments, fees, refunds, purchases, fundraising, and reimbursements;
- managing site-member accounts and restricted portals;

- providing coaching resources and access to the Coaches' Portal and Diamond Toolbox;
- improving website functionality, security, and user experience;
- preventing fraud, misuse, unauthorized access, or violations of Warriors FC policies;
- complying with legal, insurance, regulatory, tournament, governing-body, or law-enforcement requirements; and
- carrying out other purposes disclosed at or before the time information is collected.

4. Emergency, Medical and Incident Information

Safety information may be particularly sensitive. Warriors FC may collect and use emergency contacts, relevant medical information, injury information, concussion-related information, incident reports, and similar information when reasonably necessary to protect participants, respond to emergencies, administer safety procedures, document incidents, support insurance matters, or meet legal or organizational requirements.

Access to sensitive information should be limited to persons with a legitimate need to know, such as authorized administrators, coaches, safety personnel, emergency responders, insurers, medical professionals, legal advisers, or other persons as reasonably necessary and permitted by law.

Submitting medical or emergency information through a Warriors FC form does not make Warriors FC a medical provider and does not replace professional medical care or emergency services.

5. Photographs, Video and Media

Warriors FC may photograph or record activities for organizational, promotional, educational, historical, or communication purposes when appropriate and when the applicable participant or parent/guardian authorization has been obtained or another lawful basis applies.

A separate image/photo/video release may govern whether and how a participant's image may be used. Where a specific release applies, that release controls the permitted use.

Users should not photograph, record, publish, or distribute another participant's private information or image in a manner that violates Warriors FC rules, a specific release, privacy rights, or applicable law.

6. Cookies, Analytics and Website Technologies

The website and its service providers may use cookies, pixels, analytics, logs, or similar technologies to operate the website, remember preferences, understand website usage, improve performance, maintain security, and support site functionality.

Third-party services integrated into the website may collect technical or usage information under their own privacy policies. Warriors FC does not control the privacy practices of third parties.

7. How We Share Information

Warriors FC does not intend to sell personal information as a commercial data-broker product. We may share information when reasonably necessary for legitimate organizational purposes or as permitted or required by law.

Examples may include sharing with authorized Warriors FC administrators, coaches, volunteers, facility operators, tournament or governing organizations, insurance providers, payment processors, website/technology providers, emergency responders, medical professionals, legal or professional advisers, or government/law-enforcement authorities when appropriate.

We may also disclose information when necessary to protect the safety, rights, property, or security of participants, families, Warriors FC, or others; to investigate suspected misconduct or fraud; or to comply with legal obligations.

8. Coaches' Portal and Role-Based Access

The Coaches' Portal is intended for authorized Warriors FC coaches and other persons expressly approved by Warriors FC administration. Access may be controlled through site-member accounts and the Coach role.

Coach access may expose authorized users to information necessary for coaching and administration, including rosters, player status, emergency or safety resources, incident forms, facility information, and other club resources.

Coaches and other authorized users are expected to protect confidential information, use it only for legitimate Warriors FC purposes, and not copy, forward, photograph, publish, or otherwise disclose it except as authorized.

9. Data Security

Warriors FC takes reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures intended to protect information from unauthorized access, loss, misuse, alteration, or disclosure.

No internet transmission or electronic storage system can be guaranteed to be completely secure. Users should use strong passwords, protect login credentials, and promptly report suspected unauthorized access or disclosure.

Where Warriors FC uses third-party platforms, those providers may maintain their own security controls and policies.

10. Data Retention

Warriors FC may retain information for as long as reasonably necessary for the purpose for which it was collected, including program administration, safety, incident documentation, insurance, financial records, legal compliance, dispute resolution, and organizational recordkeeping.

Retention periods may vary by type of information and applicable legal, insurance, accounting, governing-body, or operational requirements. Information that is no longer reasonably needed may be deleted, destroyed, anonymized, or otherwise disposed of as appropriate.

11. Your Choices and Requests

Depending on applicable law, users may have rights or choices concerning personal information, which may include requesting access, correction, deletion, or information about certain processing activities.

Requests should be sent to SangerWarriors@gmail.com. Warriors FC may need to verify the identity and authority of the person making a request, particularly where the request concerns a minor or another person's information.

Some information may need to be retained or may not be eligible for deletion when retention is reasonably necessary for safety, legal compliance, insurance, financial records, dispute resolution, or another lawful purpose.

12. Third-Party Services

Warriors FC may use third-party services for website hosting, site membership, forms, payments, communications, scheduling, analytics, coaching resources, maps, registration, tournaments, or other operations.

Those providers may collect, use, or retain information under their own terms and privacy policies. Users should review the applicable third-party privacy notice when interacting with an external service.

Warriors FC is not responsible for privacy practices of third parties that Warriors FC does not control.

13. Payments and Financial Information

When payments are made through a third-party processor, the processor may collect payment-card and transaction information directly. Warriors FC may receive confirmation, transaction details, payment status, or other information needed for accounting and program administration.

Warriors FC may retain records of fees, purchases, refunds, reimbursements, fundraising, and other financial activity as reasonably necessary for administration, accounting, insurance, legal compliance, and dispute resolution.

14. Email, Text and Other Communications

Warriors FC may use email, text messaging, phone calls, website notices, or other communication methods to administer programs and communicate with parents, guardians, players, coaches, volunteers, and other authorized users.

Users should keep contact information current. Certain operational or safety communications may be necessary for participation and may not be optional where permitted by law.

Users should not forward confidential or sensitive Warriors FC communications to unauthorized persons.

15. Data Breach or Security Incident

If Warriors FC becomes aware of a security incident involving personal information, Warriors FC will take reasonable steps to investigate, contain, and respond to the incident and provide any notice required by applicable law.

Because Warriors FC relies in part on third-party technology providers, some incidents may originate in systems outside Warriors FC's direct control. Warriors FC will coordinate with relevant providers as appropriate.

16. Changes to This Privacy Policy

Warriors FC may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in the website, programs, technology, legal requirements, or information practices.

An updated version may be posted with a revised effective date. Where required by applicable law, Warriors FC will provide additional notice or obtain consent for material changes.

17. California Privacy Rights and Applicable Law

This Policy is intended to address privacy practices applicable to Warriors FC and its users. California privacy laws may provide specific rights depending on the individual, the type of information collected, and whether statutory thresholds or exemptions apply.

Because Warriors FC is a youth sports organization and legal requirements can vary based on organizational structure, size, services, and the information processed, Warriors FC will apply rights and obligations required by applicable law.

If a specific consent or notice describes a particular collection or use of information, that more specific document may provide additional terms for that activity. A liability release or participation waiver does not automatically authorize unrelated uses of personal information.

20. Acknowledgment

By using the Warriors FC website or submitting information through a Warriors FC service, you acknowledge that you have had an opportunity to review this Privacy Policy.

For minors, parents and legal guardians are responsible for reviewing this Policy and any specific privacy, medical, emergency, photo/video, or participation notices that apply to the minor.

Recommended final legal review: Warriors FC serves youth athletes and may handle minor-participant, emergency, health-related, incident, payment, and member-account information. A qualified California privacy attorney should review this Policy before publication to confirm that it accurately reflects Warriors FC's actual Wix configuration, third-party services, data practices, and any California or federal privacy obligations that apply.
