Website, Site Membership, Programs & Online Resources

These Terms of Service govern use of the Warriors FC website, online portals, forms, resources, communications, and related services. By accessing or using the website, creating a site-member account, submitting a form, or otherwise using a Warriors FC online service, you agree to these Terms to the extent permitted by applicable law.

IMPORTANT: These Terms are not a substitute for a separate liability release, medical authorization, participation waiver, or other document that Warriors FC may require for a player, coach, volunteer, tryout participant, parent/guardian, or other participant.

This document is intended as an operational website Terms of Service and should be reviewed by qualified California counsel before final adoption, particularly if Warriors FC changes its legal structure, payment practices, insurance arrangements, or services.

1. Acceptance of These Terms

By accessing or using the Warriors FC website or any related online service, you represent that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms, together with policies, waivers, handbooks, rules, or other documents expressly incorporated by reference.

If you are a parent or legal guardian acting on behalf of a minor, you represent that you have authority to act for that minor and are responsible for complying with these Terms and completing required parent/guardian forms.

Warriors FC may adopt additional rules for specific programs, teams, events, tryouts, tournaments, facilities, coaches, volunteers, or online areas. Those requirements may supplement or, where expressly stated, override a general website rule.

2. Warriors FC Programs and Authority

Warriors FC operates youth fastpitch softball programs and related activities. Team, practice, tournament, facility, equipment, player eligibility, coaching, guest-player, and administrative decisions may be subject to Warriors FC policies, team rules, facility requirements, governing-body rules, tournament rules, and insurance requirements.

Administrative authority. Warriors FC administration may modify, interpret, suspend, or override team-level policies, procedures, recommendations, or practices when necessary for safety, compliance, insurance, scheduling, finances, player eligibility, organizational needs, or other legitimate club purposes.

3. Website Use

Use the website only for lawful purposes and in a manner consistent with Warriors FC rules and these Terms.

Do not attempt to gain unauthorized access to restricted pages, accounts, records, forms, systems, or other users' information.

Do not upload or transmit malicious code, spam, fraudulent information, or material that violates applicable law or the rights of others.

Do not interfere with the operation, security, availability, or integrity of the website or its supporting systems.

Do not copy, scrape, republish, sell, distribute, or commercially exploit Warriors FC content except as expressly authorized.

Warriors FC may restrict, suspend, or terminate access to any website feature or account when we reasonably believe these Terms, club rules, safety requirements, or applicable law have been violated.

4. Site-Member Accounts and Restricted Areas

Certain portions of the website may require a site-member account. Warriors FC may use member roles, permissions, invitations, approvals, or other access controls to limit specific information to authorized users.

Coach access. The Coaches' Portal is intended for authorized Warriors FC coaches and other persons expressly approved by Warriors FC administration. A user must not share login credentials or allow another person to use a restricted account.

A Coach role does not automatically make a person an employee, officer, director, agent, or authorized representative of Warriors FC for every purpose. Coaches remain subject to the Coaches' Handbook and club policies.

Warriors FC may remove or change a member's role or access at any time, including when a coaching assignment ends.

5. Forms, Records and Electronic Submissions

The website may provide forms for player onboarding, tryout check-in, liability releases, guest-player requests, insurance requests, incidents, equipment, fundraising, coach communications, and other club purposes.

Users agree to provide accurate, current, and complete information to the best of their knowledge and to correct materially inaccurate information.

Submitting a form does not automatically mean a request is approved. Where approval is required, Warriors FC administration must provide the approval or otherwise confirm it.

Electronic submissions, acknowledgments, and signatures may be used where permitted by applicable law and club procedure.

Forms may contain sensitive information. Users must not access, copy, forward, photograph, or disclose another person's private information except as authorized and necessary for legitimate Warriors FC purposes.

6. Tryouts, Participation and Eligibility

Tryout participation, roster placement, player onboarding, practices, games, tournaments, and other activities may require designated forms, payment of applicable fees, proof of eligibility, insurance coverage, medical information, emergency contacts, or other requirements.

A player or participant must not participate in activities for which required documentation, approval, eligibility, or insurance coverage has not been completed or confirmed. Warriors FC may remove a participant from an activity when required documentation or eligibility is missing.

7. Safety, Medical Information and Incident Reporting

Participation in softball and related activities involves inherent risks, including falls, collisions, thrown or batted balls, equipment-related injuries, weather, travel, field conditions, and other risks associated with athletic participation.

Warriors FC may provide emergency contacts, medical information, incident-reporting tools, and safety procedures. These tools do not replace professional medical care, emergency services, or individualized medical advice.

In an emergency, participants and families should contact 911 or obtain appropriate emergency medical assistance when warranted. Required liability releases and medical authorizations are separate from these Terms.

8. Coaches, Volunteers and Parent Helpers

Authorized coaches must comply with the Warriors FC Coaches' Handbook and administrative directives. Coaches are responsible for understanding eligibility, insurance, safety, financial, disciplinary, guest-player, equipment, and conduct requirements.

Parent helpers. Parents or guardians who are not official Warriors FC coaches may assist with practices, games, tournaments, fundraising, events, transportation coordination, or other activities when permitted. A parent helper must be notified of and agree to follow the applicable Warriors FC rules and Coaches' Handbook requirements before participating in that capacity.

Ineligible players. Coaches are responsible for verifying player eligibility and required documentation before using a player when eligibility or insurance status is not confirmed. Playing an ineligible or uncovered player may expose the coach and/or team to financial, fiscal, liability, disciplinary, insurance, competitive, or other consequences, including consequences arising from an injury. Coaches acknowledge that they may be personally responsible for costs or consequences imposed on them as a result of violating Warriors FC eligibility or insurance requirements, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

Guest players. Coaches should first look within Warriors FC to fill a roster before seeking an outside guest player. Warriors FC does not generally recommend Warriors FC players guest playing for other organizations or outside players guest playing for Warriors FC. Exceptions may be granted only through Warriors FC administration and any required governing-body, tournament, or insurance approval.

9. Coaches' Portal and Diamond Toolbox

The Coaches' Portal may contain the Coaches' Handbook, forms, administrative resources, facility information, safety resources, communications, and links to the Diamond Toolbox.

The Diamond Toolbox and other coaching materials are provided for authorized coaching use. Access may be limited, modified, suspended, or revoked. Unless expressly permitted, users may not redistribute, resell, publicly post, or commercially exploit restricted coaching materials.

Coaching resources are educational and operational resources. Coaches remain responsible for professional judgment and compliance with applicable laws, safety standards, governing-body rules, and Warriors FC directives.

10. Fees, Fundraising and Team-Collected Money

Teams or coaches may collect money for legitimate team purposes, including fundraising, tournament fees, game fees, umpire fees, equipment fees, and approved player-purchase requirements.

Coaches must not represent team-collected funds as money collected by or on behalf of Warriors FC unless expressly authorized.

Money collected must be used only for the stated and intended purpose.

Coaches should not collect money more than 30 days in advance unless an event or other requirement requires earlier collection.

Any specialized or team financial account should have access for at least two people; Warriors FC recommends that at least one authorized account holder be a non-coach.

Coaches must maintain appropriate records of money received and spent and provide documentation when requested.

Nothing here authorizes a coach to incur debt, sign a contract, open an account, commit Warriors FC to a purchase, or represent that Warriors FC is financially responsible for a team expense unless expressly authorized.

11. Fundraising, Sponsorships and Commercial Activity

Fundraising and sponsorship activities must comply with Warriors FC procedures and required approvals. Coaches and families must accurately describe who is collecting funds and the purpose for which funds will be used.

No user may use Warriors FC branding, logos, name, social-media accounts, mailing lists, contacts, or other organizational resources for an outside commercial purpose without prior authorization.

12. Equipment, Facilities and Property

Participants and coaches must use Warriors FC, facility, tournament, and team equipment appropriately and follow applicable facility rules.

A person who loses, misuses, intentionally damages, or negligently damages property may be required to pay the reasonable cost of repair or exact/similar replacement where permitted by law and Warriors FC policy.

Access to Arrowhead Training Facility or other facilities may be limited to reserved times, approved dates, and authorized activities. Requests for additional access should use the designated Warriors FC process.

13. Intellectual Property and Warriors FC Branding

The Warriors FC name, logos, graphics, designs, website content, text, documents, forms, handbooks, coaching resources, photographs, videos, and other materials may be protected by intellectual-property or other rights.

Except for content you independently own or are expressly authorized to use, you may not copy, modify, distribute, sell, publish, create derivative works from, or commercially exploit Warriors FC materials without permission.

Nothing in these Terms transfers ownership of Warriors FC intellectual property to a user. Limited access to a resource is permission to use it for the intended club purpose, not a sale or transfer of ownership.

14. User-Submitted Content and Communications

Users may submit information, messages, photographs, documents, comments, reports, or other content through Warriors FC services. You represent that you have the right to submit the content and that doing so does not violate another person's rights or applicable law.

By submitting content for club administration, you grant Warriors FC the limited right to receive, store, review, and use that content as reasonably necessary to operate the club, administer programs, respond to requests, maintain records, address safety matters, and comply with legal or insurance requirements, subject to the Privacy Policy and any more specific consent provided with the applicable form.

15. Privacy

Warriors FC's collection and use of personal information is governed by its Privacy Policy, as updated from time to time. Users should review the Privacy Policy before creating an account or submitting personal information.

Because Warriors FC serves youth athletes, parents and guardians should take particular care when submitting information concerning minors. Users must not submit another person's information unless they have appropriate authority to do so.

16. Third-Party Services and Links

The website may link to or use third-party services, websites, payment processors, registration systems, mapping tools, communication platforms, coaching resources, tournament systems, or other services. Warriors FC does not control third-party services and is not responsible for their content, availability, security, policies, or practices.

A link or reference does not necessarily mean Warriors FC endorses the third party or guarantees its products or services.

17. Payments, Purchases and Refunds

Where the website or a linked service permits payments, the applicable fee, payment terms, refund rules, cancellation rules, and other conditions will be disclosed through the applicable registration, checkout, invoice, or policy.

Warriors FC may use third-party payment processors. Payment information may be handled by the processor under its own terms and privacy practices.

Nothing in these Terms overrides a specific written refund, cancellation, tournament, registration, or fee policy that expressly applies to the transaction.

18. Disclaimers

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Warriors FC website and online resources are provided on an “as available” and “as is” basis. Warriors FC does not guarantee that the website, forms, portals, links, communications, or resources will always be available, accurate, complete, uninterrupted, secure, or error-free.

Warriors FC does not provide medical, legal, financial, tax, or other professional advice through its website or coaching resources.

Participation in softball and related activities may involve risks that cannot be eliminated. Any separate participation waiver, liability release, medical authorization, or similar agreement controls the matters addressed by that document.

19. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Warriors FC and its directors, officers, coaches, volunteers, agents, and service providers will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary, or punitive damages arising from or related to use of the website or online resources.

Nothing in these Terms is intended to waive or limit liability that cannot lawfully be waived or limited, including rights or liabilities that applicable law requires to remain available.

20. Indemnification

To the extent permitted by law, a user agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Warriors FC and its directors, officers, coaches, volunteers, agents, and service providers from claims, losses, liabilities, damages, costs, and reasonable expenses arising from the user’s unauthorized use of the website, violation of these Terms, violation of another person’s rights, or unlawful or intentionally wrongful conduct.

21. Suspension and Termination

Warriors FC may suspend or terminate website access, site-member status, Coach role access, or use of particular resources when reasonably necessary for safety, security, administration, compliance, conduct, eligibility, financial, or other legitimate club purposes.

Termination does not automatically eliminate obligations that by their nature should survive, including intellectual property, confidentiality, indemnification, disclaimers, limitations of liability, dispute resolution, and outstanding payment obligations.

22. Changes to the Website or These Terms

Warriors FC may change the website, features, programs, forms, resources, policies, or these Terms from time to time. Updated Terms may be posted with a revised effective date. Continued use after an update becomes effective constitutes acceptance to the extent permitted by law.

For material changes, Warriors FC may provide additional notice when appropriate. It is the user's responsibility to review the current version.

23. Governing Law and Venue

These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of California, without regard to conflict-of-law principles, except to the extent a different rule is required by applicable law.

Subject to any mandatory law or dispute-resolution provision that applies, disputes relating to these Terms or use of the Warriors FC website shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction in California, with venue determined under applicable law.

24. Severability

If any provision is determined to be unlawful, invalid, or unenforceable, that provision will be enforced to the maximum extent permitted by law, and the remaining provisions will remain in effect.

25. No Waiver

A failure by Warriors FC to enforce a provision of these Terms on one occasion does not waive the right to enforce that provision or another provision later.

26. Entire Agreement and Order of Precedence

These Terms, together with policies and documents expressly incorporated by reference, constitute the applicable agreement concerning use of the website. If a specific written agreement, waiver, handbook provision, registration term, or administrative directive expressly conflicts with these Terms, the more specific requirement will control for the subject matter addressed, to the extent permitted by law.

For minors, the parent or legal guardian is responsible for reviewing these Terms and any additional participation documents applicable to the minor.

Separate documents may apply. Warriors FC may require additional documents, including liability releases, medical/emergency forms, participant waivers, coach liability releases, tryout check-in waivers, the Coaches' Handbook, Privacy Policy, Refund & Cancellation Policy, Digital Product Policy, and other club policies. Completing one document does not necessarily satisfy another document's requirements.

Recommended final review: Because these Terms are intended for a California youth-sports organization and may interact with liability releases, insurance, minors, privacy, fundraising, and team operations, Warriors FC should have the final version reviewed by a qualified California attorney before relying on it as a legal contract.
